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Parade Information and Rules

2019 Theme: Celebrate Hampden!

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Parade Line Up Begins at 10 AM at Reeds Brook Middle School 28a Main Road South Hampden

Parade kicks off at 11 AM and proceeds left out Reeds Brook driveway, left at the intersection of Western Avenue, continues down Western Avenue ending at the Intersection of RT 202 (Hampden Academy entrance). Parade units needing to pick up vehicles etc., may enter at the Hampden Academy driveway and follow the road towards the back where the road meets the back parking area of Reeds Brook Middle School.

PLEASE NOTE FOR 2019-Parade Route May Vary depending on Route 1 A Construction Project. More information will be provided on Route with Parade Email Reminder Sent out the week of August 5th, 2019.

Safety is our #1 priority...No items may be thrown into the parade crowds from a parade entry. Candy, water, balls, pencils, Frisbees, etc. may be handed out by walkers. We encourage to walkers to stick to one side of the street and avoid crossing during the parade. Please watch for parade walkers and parade watchers who may enter the parade route.

Water guns, water balloons and spraying/shooting water into the parade crowd is not allowed.

No political advertisements are allowed. This includes printed political information handed to parade watchers. This Day is for the celebration of Children!

Mind the gap. Please allow 20-30 ft. between entries. Some entries will stop to perform during the route. Please be mindful of the delay time, and continue on the route limiting the gap as much as possible.

Parade line up area is for parade participants and parade units only. Personal vehicles must be parked at the back gym parking lot of Reeds Brook Middle School or back teacher parking lot of Hampden Academy. No parking on the roadway/driveway of the school yards. Personal vehicles must be in designated parking space.

Parade units are encouraged to decorate or craft their unit to follow the year's theme selected. Parade units will be judged by select children who have participated in our theme and poster contest programs or designated Grand Marshall. Judging will occur at line up just before the parade kicks off.

Parade awards will be announced just prior to the fireworks display on the event day. First and Second place awards will be given in the following judging categories: Theme Specific Entry, For Profit Business Entry, and Non Profit Entry. Parade awards will be delivered to winners as needed.

All parade units with animals must have provide their own waste pick up crew following closely behind their unit for immediate removal of waste. All animals shall be under the handler's control during the parade, and handlers are expected to monitor their animal's safety and comfort. Units with live animals will be positioned towards the back of the parade line up whenever possible.

Please watch all children participating in the parade carefully. Do not allow parade participants to hang off/over the sides of a moving vehicle. Tailgates should be closed. Participants should remain seated when possible. Remember a safe parade is a great parade!

No open flames, or pyrotechnic displays or devices allowed.

Please indicate on your parade entry form if you intend to use/play music or make siren noise during the parade route, to plan for proper spacing and line up of units.

Please also indicate on your parade entry form if you intend to pass out any candy or trinkets to parade spectators.
